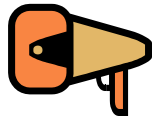
**Used Uniform Sale:** We need your old uniforms for the next Ice Cream Social!!!! Bring in your old uniforms to the office either before the end of the year or during summer office hours! The more uniforms we have to sell, the more we make for the playground on August 25th!

**Legacy Wall:** Because we wanted to give people one more chance to be a part of it, the Legacy tile wall will not be completed at the same time as the playground. The last chance to buy and paint tiles will be at the Ice Cream Social on August 25th.

**Get your volunteer hours for 2010-2011 done this summer or early next school year!** To save a little money, we were hoping that there was a family in construction or landscape/hardscape that would be willing to donate their time to 1) build the wall AND/OR 2) install the tiles when the wall is complete. What kind of wall? Seating wall/cinder block bench that is roughly 80 linear feet and 24" high, stucco finish base (to match school buildings) and precast concrete cap, with standard footings. 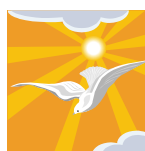
